

Humanitarian corridors in figures

Data updated on December 3, 2021

The humanitarian corridors - implemented by the Community of Sant'Egidio with various religious associations and entities, in accordance with the protocols signed with the countries involved - have enabled 4,315 people to reach Europe safely from February 2016 to 3 December 2021.

The most represented countries of origin of refugees are Syria (70%) and Eritrea (15%); followed by Afghanistan, Somalia, South Sudan, Iraq and Yemen.

Italy

So far, Italy has welcomed 3,605 people from the following countries:
