

Humanitarian corridors in figures

Data updated on January 14, 2022

The humanitarian corridors - implemented by the Community of Sant'Egidio with various religious associations and entities, in accordance with the protocols signed with the countries involved - have enabled 4,342 people to reach Europe safely from February 2016.

The most represented countries of origin of refugees are Syria (67%) and Eritrea (16,1%); followed by Afghanistan, Somalia, South Sudan, Iraq and Yemen.

Italy

So far, Italy has welcomed 3,632 people from the following countries:

Other European countries

France has admitted 532 people, of whom 530 from Lebanon and 2 from Greece.

Belgium received 150 people from Lebanon and Turkey

Andorra welcomed 16 people from Lebanon.

Moreover, through a relocation programme, Germany and Switzerland respectively welcomed nine and three people from Greece.
